Core Training

Participate in basic leadership training for teen Girl Scouts. Core training will consist of two (8) hour sessions of training covering the following topics: the role of the Program Aide, working with adults, leadership and communication skills, child development, team building, and Girl Scout program; as well as a Zink the Zebra diversity workshop and resources for songs and outdoor skills. We have also integrated the new GSLE (Girl Scout Leadership Experience) model—Discover, Connect, Take Action into this training. Girls entering Leadership Programs such as Day Camp, and other events where they will be eligible to lead younger girls, can earn the PA pin and PA patch by attending the two Sessions of PA Training.
